**SELF EMPOWERMENT PROJECT LAUNCHES FOR YOUNG WOMEN IN
FOSTER CARE**

Kickoff day of 3-week camp set to empower young women in the Miami foster care system

Miami, FL – 12 May 2009 Young women about to “age out” of the foster care system will participate in an all-day event previewing the upcoming Mind, Body and Soul camp, as part of the Girls’ Leadership Project (GLP), hosted by Educate Tomorrow, Corp.

This orientation will introduce activities and topics to be explored further during the 3 week camp. Young women will participate in yoga workshops, networking meals, and presentations by community speakers on Saturday May 30, 2009 from 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. at Pinecrest Gardens.

This year alone, 150 young women will “age out” of foster care in Miami-Dade County. Less than 40% of these women will finish high school, and 50% will become homeless within a year. Within four years, approximately 70% of these young women will become pregnant. “With the guidance and education obtained through the camp, we hope these youth will be inspired to rise above statistical predictions and lead successful, productive lives through self empowerment,” said Tania Socarras, GLP Director.

Educate Tomorrow is a not for profit international organization whose mission is to reach out to disadvantaged individuals and guide them in obtaining further education. Educate Tomorrow strives to improve peoples lives from remote villages to large metropolitan areas by giving them confidence, knowledge, motivation and the means to improve their lives through education.
